Writing Devotions Session InkSlingers – June 18, 2011 – Emily M. Akin

How to write a devotion:

- 1. Choose a format. Each publication has its own requirements for content, style, length.
- 2. Make a template to fit your chosen style.
- 3. Select a scripture. Use translation preferred by target pub. Type it into template.
- 4. Journal on chosen scripture by hand or on the computer.
- 5. Read the scripture in context---one or more chapters before and after.
- 6. Consult Bible commentaries and/or dictionaries for background. Add details to your journal notes. Don't quote the commentary. Just use it to get the big picture.
- 7. Write. Lead sentence needs to draw the reader in. Don't be concerned about word count for first draft.
- 8. Second draft. I'll quote E. B. White: "Omit needless words." You must adhere to the word count if submitting for publication.
- 9. Print a hard copy and let it rest overnight (if possible). Then, proofread and make corrections. I always like to ask someone else to check it before I submit.
- 10. Double-check submission guidelines and submit according to every detail of the guidelines.
